




# How to find TMA by train

Theresan Military Academy – AUSTRIA



Once you have arrived at Wiener Neustadt train station head east to leave the station by the main gates. From here you have three options:

## Option A: Walk (approximately [app.] 7 minutes [min.]/ app. 800 meters [m.]

- Head straight on along the Bahngasse for 700 meters until you get to the crossing with the Grazer Straße (big street, 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic lights). You should see the Academy on your far right side just across the street.
- Cross the Grazer Straße at the traffic lights ahead and turn left/south to pass the Academy by your left hand side.
- Once you passed it (app. 50 meters after the traffic lights) there is an open gate to your left and another traffic light to your right.
- Turn left to enter through this gate and head straight on for app. 30 meters.
- The southern entrance gate is now to your left. A small bridge leads to it and it is flanked by a small guards house in red and white stripes.
- The eastern entrance gate is just around the corner opening to the Maria Theresan square to the east.
- During service times at least one of these two gates is open and guarded. At nighttimes and on weekends they can be closed both so don't hesitate to ring for the guard using the bell at the left hand side of the door.
- Talk to the guard to enter the Academy.

## Option B: Take the bus (app. 7-15 min./ 1,80 €)

- Buses leave from in front of the station just north the main gates.
- Take any one of these buses: A, B, D, F, G, H. You could also take the E bus, but do it from the bus station across the street next to the Admiral Sportwetten Café.
- Exit at the stop called Wr. Neustadt Akademie (MILAK) or just Akademie on some lines.
- Cross the street at the traffic lights.
- Enter the gates and head straight on for app. 30 meters.
- The southern entrance gate is now to your left. A small bridge leads to it and it is flanked by a small guards house in red and white stripes.
- The eastern entrance gate is just around the corner opening to the Maria Theresan square to the east.
- During service times at least one of these two gates is open and guarded. At nighttimes and on weekends they can both be closed so don't hesitate to ring for the guard using the bell at the left hand side of the door.
- Talk to the guard to enter the Academy.

## Option C: Grab a cab (app. 5 min./ app. 7 €)

- Taxis leave from in front of the train station.
- Ask the cabby to be brought to the Military academy's southern gate.
- The eastern entrance gate is just around the corner opening to the Maria Theresan square to the east.
- During service times at least one of these two gates will always be open and guarded. At nighttimes and on weekends they can both be closed so don't hesitate to ring for the guard using the bell at the left hand side of the door.
- Talk to the guard to enter the Academy.
