Ukrainian M1 Abrams Tanks Get Elaborate 'Cope Cages,' Soviet Explosive Reactive Armor



New defenses are appearing on Ukraine's M1 Abrams tanks after at least a quarter of them have been knocked out, primarily by drones. Pictures of one of the modified Abrams show it has received a "cope cage" on the turret and an additional explosive reactive armor (ERA).
